This Cohort's Future Stroke Leaders Programme theme is *"Implementation of Quality Stroke Care"* with the following areas of focus:

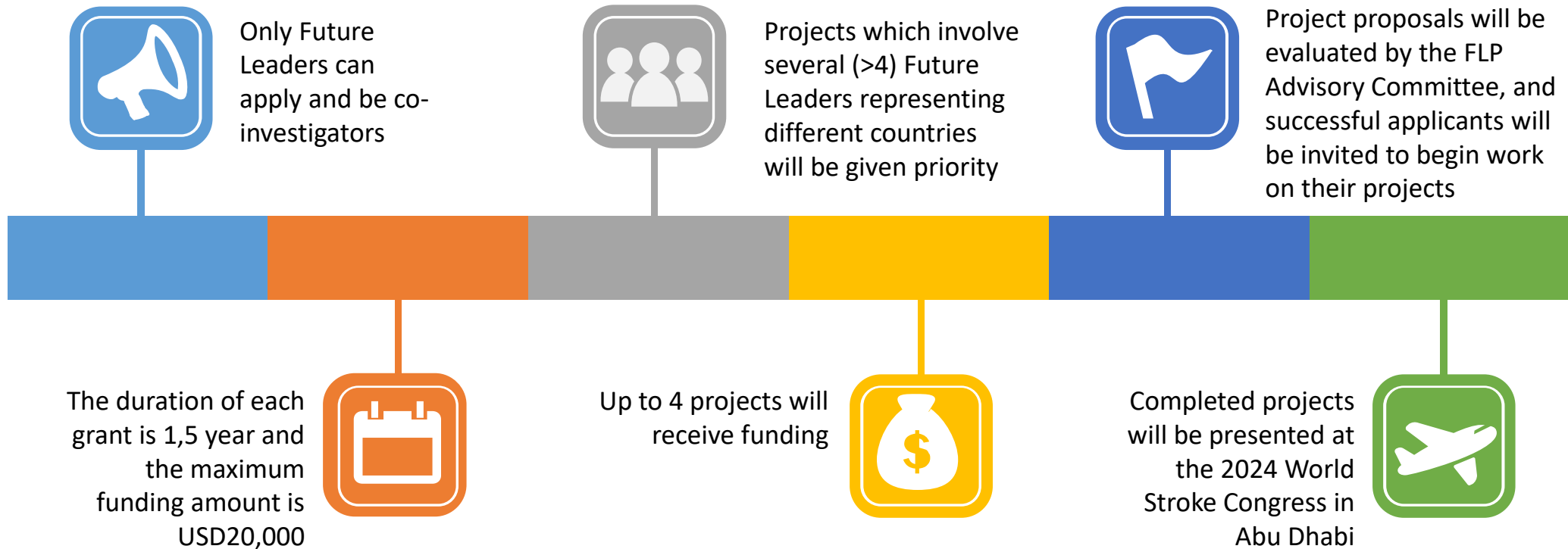

Funded project essentials

- Withing key focus areas
- ***Innovative***
- Scientifically valid
- Have clear aims, hypotheses and outcomes
- Must meet the project timeframe of 1 year and use the funds sensibly



Funded projects: use SMART goals

S	M	A	R	T
Specific	Measurable	Attainable	Relevant	Time-Bound
Add in as many details as possible. What will you do? Why and by when?	Make sure your goal is trackable. How will you measure your goal?	Take time to reflect. Can you realistically accomplish this goal within a certain timeline?	Think about what is important to you. Does this goal align with your values and larger objectives and goals?	Keep yourself accountable. By when do you want to accomplish this goal? How long will it take?

Financial management

- International Grants Management Processes
- Start checking now
- Finance Team MOU processes
- Spreading funds among members



Funded project mentoring

- Assigned on the stage of **project proposal**
- 2-3 mentors per group
- Try to make independent decisions as Mentors are invited to establishing the future leaders as independent researchers and leaders
- Initiate meetings (collect questions and send together)
- 2 hrs per month dedicated time



1st Project Proposal – 26th May 2023

- **Send to Julia by 5pm CET on May 26th, 2023**
- **1 page max**
- Include project members and their locations, project background, outline, specific objectives, methods, expected outcomes (impact and future directions).

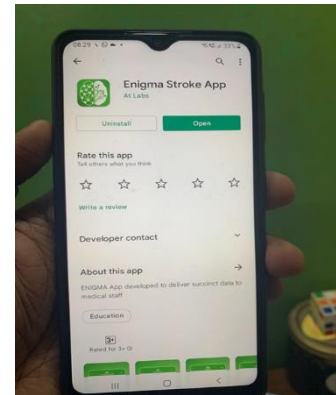
